

185 kilos less - a useful contribution!

The results of the **Green Cone** trials carried out for the County Council in West Sussex in 2002/03, which were monitored by the University of Brighton, have now been released. It all makes good reading with the University concluding that " *on average each **Green Cone** would remove 185 kilos of waste from the waste stream in a year*". Furthermore the University found that 78% of users would recommend a **Green Cone** to a friend.
